BRUCE FROMAN, IDAHO KEENEY HISTORIAN,

BRUCE EVERETT FROMAN, son of Jesse J. and Henrietta J. (BRUNS) Froman, passed away June 20, 2004 at his home in Meridian, Idaho. Bruce is survived by his wife, Audrey; sons, Jay, Bernard, and Bruce Jr.; 9 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; his half-brother Charles; his 2 sisters, Berna & Shirley; and his daughter, Candace.

Bruce was born and raised in Caldwell, Idaho until his family sold their business in Caldwell and moved to Star, Idaho. Bruce graduated from Star High School in 1943 and immediately joined the U.S. Navy. He spent his WWII service in the South Pacific.

Bruce attended "CAL POLY" in San Luis Obispo, California where he received a degree in Ornamental Horticulture. He later attended the University of Idaho where he received another degree in Agribusiness.

Bruce was an active member of the Church Of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. He spent 10 years working as a volunteer at the local Family History Center. It was thru this effort that he began researching his own family roots and learned about his FROMAN, BRUNS, and KEENEY heritage. (Bruce was a great grandson of Captain Jonathan KEENEY.)

EULOGY

The date was October 19, 1927. The time was after dark but not yet bedtime. The upstairs room at Witcher where we kids (aged from 2 to 5 to 7, to 10) usually romped) was the scene. Mom and Dad's bedroom, next to the room where the four boys usually slept, was blocked off. Our older sisters were drafted to keep us under control and to assist as needed. Both rooms were heated by open grate fireplaces, welcomed in early fall.

A baby cry from mom's room brought sudden attention. Very soon someone opened the door and presented to us our new brother, the eighth and last for Roscoe Sr and Maggie Paxton Keeney. Calvin at age 2+ was most excited. He had been told he'd have a new brother and all he could yell was "Billie, Billie, Billie". There was no doubt what the new bundle would be named.

A baby bed with four sides soon was added to the crowded furnishings upstairs. My most visible memory came when dad had a payday and those at Charlie King's store, as was their custom, gave us a bag of candy along with balloons upon payment of our grocery bill. I was enamored by my very own balloon, a luxury I'd seldom enjoyed. With effort I blew it up, tied it, and ad dropped it in the baby bed. Billie's delight quickly resulted in a big "pop" and my cherished possession went into oblivion. I don't think I every forgave my new brother.

Dad was reluctant to let any of us leave his sight, even to go to school. Yet since I was born in September, I luckily started school at age 6 at the one-room school at Witcher. Bill, however, being born in late October, was prevented school entry since the school board ruled out those under six. To add insult to injury, Dad exercised his authority by keeping Bill out of school for an additional year, postponing his formal education until 1929.. I don't know how much this contributed to Billie's attitude toward teachers and learning.

When our new brother was six weeks old, he sat on his mother's lap as a in a downstairs parlor, seldom used, to witness the first marriage among the eight of us, sister Julia Hannah (named for her grandmother) and Douglas Robert Arthur, of Fayette County. The couple lived downstairs in our very crowded house until Doug took a construction job at Clintonville WV.

With so many children, Mom couldn't go to church except on Sunday evenings, when she would see that we washed our faces, put on our best clothes, and filled a complete pew at the Witcher Baptist Church. We soon learned all the hymns by rote and sang them throughout the weeks.

Bill was the youngest member of the Witcher boys baseball team, with dad's brother, Uncle Ebon, as coach. The team was composed of Keeney first cousins, as well as Meadows, Douglass, Kincaid and other cousins in the neighborhood.

Making it through the grades at Witcher and Belle schools, Bill entered junior high at Chelyan, where cousin Hannah Keeney was one of his best teachers. By this time, Mom had died in gall bladder surgery in 1945, I had been in the Army, stationed in Mississippi and Texas, and Calvin was in the Army, stationed in Hawaii. Bill was completely lost without a mother who worshipped him, and brothers in service. Dad made a noble effort to work and prepare meals, but nothing matched Mom's cooking and Bill turned elsewhere for attention.

The main attention centered on a schoolmate, Sarah Jacqueline Bayless, from the Harlow family of Cabin Creek. They made a logical couple, since Jackie was being raised by a strict grandmother, and looked forward to being on her own. They were married in 1947 (Jackie was 16) and, after 4 kids and 23 years of moving from place to place, including work near Bill's sisters, Frances Kilburn and Margaret Cline, in Wyandotte, Michigan for a few years, followed by a return to Witcher and Shressbury, finally divorced in 1970.

Son Bill (William Harold Jr), born in 1948, was ready for college when his parents parted. Son Roy David, born in 1951, was most affected by the turn of events in the family, once "getting lost in the woods" while his dad, brother Bill and I searched the woods and river for him. Sister Frances Kay, born in 1954 and son Douglas Ross (named for Douglas Arthur) were left with their dad and other relatives. Their Dad, Bill Sr., became associated with Parents Without Partners (serving as while as president), resulting in marriage to Eileen Campsey, whose previous marriage had ended.

Brother Bill was a new man and the new marriage was filled with the

warmth and affection which had been missing. The children of both Bill and Eileen (now adults) blended into one family and a house on Elm St. In South Charleston became a home, as Eileen had a good job which she loved and Bill established himself by selling insurance. The sons became graduates of Concord College and married college classmates, both of whom became successful teachers. Frankie's life was not so pleasant, but after living and working several years in the Wheeling area, she and her present husband are settling in Arizona. Doug (born 1956) served in the US Navy, on the Mediterranean and throughout the world, returning to work as a horticulturist, and married Anita Dawn Snodgrass of Boone Co. They are parents of Andrew Douglas (a WVU student) and Ashley Dawn (Capitol High graduate), employed in Charleston.

Bill's parents and siblings became Christians early in life and much of their lives was devoted to church. Bill was active in the Witcher Baptist Church and became a deacon at the new Southern Baptist Church in South Charleston. It is there that last rites will be held. 10-31-2004

Madison County Biography of:

Charles S. KEENEY was born in Osage County, Mo., in 1852, and is a son of **Calvin L. and Mary E. (BOATRIGHT) Keeney**. The father was born in Anderson County, Tenn., and was a son of **Michael KEENEY**, one of the leading pioneer settlers of East Tennessee.

Calvin was an educated man, taught school some time and was married about 1842, immediately settling upon a farm in Tennessee. In 1850 he moved to Osage County, Mo., and until 1855 taught school and farmed. He then followed the same occupations in Madison County, Ark., until the war, when he went north and enlisted in the Union cause. He served until 1864, and died at Fayetteville, Ark.

The mother was a daughter of the Rev. **Chesley BOATRIGHT**, a minister of the Missionary Baptist Church. The **BOATRIGHT** family of America belonged to the King's body guard, and escaping settled in America prior to the Revolution, in which they took an active part.

The Rev. **Chesley BOATRIGHT** was a native of Virginia, and came to Madison County as a missionary of the Baptist Church when the country was but sparsely settled. He established the first Baptist Church in Northwest Arkansas, and was one of the best known men in the Cherokee Nation.

Mrs. KEENEY was borne the following children: **Mary L.**, **James M.** (killed during the war), **John C.**, **Chesley S.**, **Minerva B.** (wife of **R. M. DUTTON**), one daughter (the wife of **Rev. E. A. BARRY**), and **Susan D.** (wife of **Dr. W. A. HARRIS**). **Mrs. KEENEY** is an active member of the church.

Our subject received his education at the common schools, Clark's academy of Berryville and at Fayetteville, finally becoming one of the leading teachers of the county. He is now the owner of a nice farm of sixty-six acres, a short distance north of Hindsville.

He is a member of the Little Spring Lodge No. 230 at Hindsville, and fills the office of High Priest in the Little Rock Chapter, A. F. & A. M. He has filled every office in the Chapter and Blue Lodge at Hindsville, and has twice been Illustrious Master of the council. In politics he is a Democrat." (*Goodspeeds History of NW AR...*)

Calvin L. KEENEY was the son of **James Michael and Mary LEACH Keeney**. **Mary E. BOATRIGHT Keeney** was the daughter of **Rev. Chesley and Louisa TAYLOR Boatright**. **Chesley BOATRIGHT**, Baptist Minister, is listed as head of HH #113 Prairie Twp, 1850 Madison Co AR, Census.

Willard F. Keeney

Willard F. Keeney is a member of **Butterfield, Keeney & Amberg**, attorneys-at-law. He was born at **Arcoia, Illinois**, January 25, 1862, a son of **Daniel and Rhoda (White) Keeney**, both of whom were born at **Dumfries, Ontario**. The father was of American parentage and came with his parents to Kent County at the age of six years; the mother was of American and English parentage and came to Kent County a few years later with her family, at the age of eight years. They were educated and married in Michigan, but for a few years lived in Illinois, where the father was engaged in Business. They returned, however, to Kent County in 1864. **Willard F. Keeney** was educated in the public schools of **Grand Rapids**, graduating from the high school in 1879. He then went to the University of Michigan, where he became a student in the literary and law departments, though a graduate of neither department. In 1882, he returned to **Grand Rapids** and entered the office of **Roger W. Butterfield**, being admitted to the bar in the following year. On January 1, 1887, Mr. Butterfield and he formed the firm of **Butterfield & Keeney** and continued in partnership in that name and in the name of its successor firm, **Butterfield, Keeney & Amberg**, until Mr. Butterfield's death thirty-three and one-half years later. After Mr. Butterfield's death, the firm name continued without change. **Roger C. Butterfield** and **Julius H. Amberg** are the junior partners. On November 10, 1897, Mr. Keeney married **Miss Margaret Morton**, of **Fall River, Massachusetts**, daughter of **James Madison Morton** and **Emily (Canedy) Morton**. **Mrs. Keeney's** father was for many years a Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court of Massachusetts. There are three children of the marriage, **Willard F., Jr.**; **Morton** and **Roger Butterfield Keeney**. **Mrs. Keeney** died on January 18, 1920. She was of domestic tastes and devoted to her family. She was a graduate of **Vassar College** and during her residence at **Grand Rapids** was active in the **Women's University Club** and in various movements touching the finer life of the community, particularly those which were educational in character.
