FRANCES KEENEY

To the casual passerby the little log cabin across the road from Hager's Mill is just another shabby little log cabin, a reminder of a day long past. To those who know its history, it is a symbol of faith, courage and romance of a young couple numbered among the first permanent settlers who established a home in the wilderness of the Murdy Creek Valley. It is also a link between the history of the Greenbrier Valley and that of the Kanawha Valley.

"The cabin with the tiny windows, rock chimney and small stairway which leads to a loft room, is the three section log house built nearly 300 years ago by Michael Keeney, one of the earliest settlers. It was to this home that Michael took his bride, Catherine Lewis, known to her family and friends as Katie." (From Alderson News)
Katie was born about 1759 on a pioneer farm on the Compesture River in Bath Co., Va.

Her parents, John and Mary McGreery Lewis, brought her to the big levels in Greenbrier. Her father was a relative of Gen. Andrew Lewis, who was a veteran of the Battle of Point Pleasant. Her mother was a sister of Andrew Donally, who built Fort Donally and was an early JP in Kanawha County.

They were married January 11, 1791 by Elder John Alderson of the Old Greenbrier Baptist Church.

Michael's land, along with that of his brother John, extended from the mouth of Mill Creek to the foothills of Keeney Mountain, which bore the family name. John's land also was the site of Fort Archuleta, affording some protection from the Indians.

In 1799 Michael became ill and died, leaving Katie a widow with 4 children. The oldest was S. Michael, however, had left her in good circumstances. After 3 years of widowhood, Katie wedded William Hilliard, who had been one of the 26 men who had aided Col. George Clendenin in the establishment of Fort Lee, which became Charleston.

With the children, Katie and her husband traveled by horseback to Deary Valley, now Putnam County, where they started a new home.

What happened to the cabin? It is still there, as pictured just a few weeks ago. The Fisher's Mill, however, is being moved to a new site. The owner of the cabin and land lives in Delaware and the caretaker is Mrs. Sue Hanna, a friendly cooperator.

Contact has been made with Mr. Fisher concerning the future disposition of the cabin. Watch for details.

WILLIAM S. KEENEY was the oldest son of Moses Walls Keeneey (1797-1890) and Mary D. Huff. He was born, raised and lived on Gablin Creek. This update comes mostly from obituaries and Kanawha County Birth/Death records. It is believed that the family ran a boarding house (club house) for miners at Eskdale. His brothers and sisters were John H. Keeneey (1829), Joseph H. Keeneey (1832), Moses Walls Keeneey, Jr. (1835), Thomas C. (Washington) Keeneey (1837), Harrison Columbus Keeneey (1840), Frances A. (Pamela) Keeneey (1842) and Caroline V. Keeneey Batten (1845).

Blind Hitchhikers Make It To Shrine

GENEVA, N.Y. (AP) - Roger and Ferno Keeney wanted to get to the Goodall Hall of Fame in Cooperstown and they did it in the Greenback because they were blind.

Never Keeney of legally blind and his wife, Ferno, is totally blind.

Traveling Tuesday saw 80 miles from their home in Haza. They were able to get as far as Genesee by bus. But they learned they couldn't get a bus from there north to Cooperstown 30 miles away, and the next morning.

So they decided to hitchhike the rest of the way.

Someone reported them to Geneva police as "impaired characters," but police questioned the Keeneys and let them go on their way.

They made it to Cooperstown, getting rides from three different motorists. Roger Keeney wanted to update the Hall of Fame exhibit on "loop-ball."

That's a special version of softball played by sightless people. They use a ball and two bats that have electronic devices to sound a beeping tone.

Keeney says the exhibit is due to open in the spring.
