The Justice Department asked that the entire 6th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Cincinnati review a court panel's finding that the department's Office of Special Investigations defrauded the court while going after Cleveland songwriter John Demjanjuk extradited to Israel to stand trial for his alleged role in Nazi war crimes. The Minneapolis-St. Paul Star Tribune reported that Deputy Assistant Attorney General John Keeney is indicating that federal prosecutors are "leaning in the direction of reindicting" Sen. Dave Durenberger (R-Minn.) on charges that he conspired to improperly collect Senate travel reimbursement funds.

DESCRIPTION Percussion lock. - Stamped on side plate,
"Middle, Conn. 1850. U. S. Heston." *

Heston, undoubtedly this lock was from a U. S. Martial single-shot pistol.
Was owned by Captain Jonathan Keeney, Linn County, a pioneer of 1841. He also served in the Indian War of 1855-56. Later Captain Keeney traded this rifle to James F. Lewis for a shotgun.
