Church honoring longtime minister

Highawn Baptist slates special service

When LeRoy Keene was called from Grantsville in January 1949 to become the first pastor of a just-established church in St. Albans, it was to a congregation of 22 charter members. When Keene retired from Highland Baptist Church in 1987, as the only pastor the church had known in 37 years, he left behind a church membership of 1,100.

Keene will be honored in a special service at 11 a.m. Sunday at the church when he will be officially named pastor emeritus. Representatives from the West Virginia Baptist Convention will be present, and there will be special presentations and special singing. Keene said he thinks it's most generous of the church and appreciators the honor he will be given. "I realize they're not obligated to do a thing like this and appreciate the recognition of the many years of service," he said.

A fellowship service also will be held at 2 p.m. to honor Keene and his wife. The service is to reflect on the history of the church. The Rev. Ronald W. Lee, who succeeded Keene as pastor of the church, said charter members and former staff members, as well as those who have attended Highawn over the years, are invited to both services as well as a reception, which will be held following the afternoon service.

When Keene arrived in St. Albans to pioneer Highawn Baptist Church, the congregation was meeting with supply pastors in the old Highawn Theater on Grant Street (now housing Bethany Baptist Church).

Land was purchased with money given by the West Virginia Baptist Convention and with funding from the American Baptist Home Missionary Society. The church cornerstone was laid in September 1949 at the present site of the church on the corner of Jefferson Avenue and Vine Street.

The following Easter, a congregation of 150 to 200 worshipped in a new building, sitting on folding chairs because there were no pews. The church continued to grow, needing more classrooms, and in 1954 work began on the first floor of a second building for Sunday school. In 1962, a second sanctuary was added, with the first sanctuary becoming an education building and fellowship hall. In 1973 a gymnasium with Sunday school rooms created it was built.

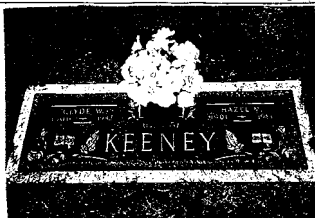
LeROY KEENEY officially will be named pastor emeritus on Sunday in St. Albans.

Keene's retirement in 1986 came two months before his 65th birthday. Since that time, he has served at various churches on an interim basis and also substitutes when pastors are on vacation or ill. He serves as a volunteer chaplain at Thomas Memorial Hospital and stays busy as president of the W.Va. Baptist Education Society, a position he has held for the past 20 years.

Keene also served as an Albemarle-Broadus College trustee for 18 years, was a member of the State Convention Executive Board and president of the state convention in 1965. He was instrumental in developing the St. Albans Ministerial Association, the first major kindergarten in the area, first church softball and basketball leagues, a deaf ministry, and a special education class.

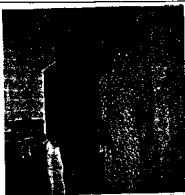

ALONZO FOSTER BEVLY, b. 6th July, 1810, at Batavia, New York; d. 10th April,
 1870, at Adrian, Michigan; received his education at Granville College, Ohio, after
 which he read law in Adrian, Michigan, with the firm of BAKER, MILLARD and
 HARRIS; after being admitted to practice law, he decided to go South, influenced
 by a tendency to lung trouble; he went to La Grange in the Republic of Texas where
 he practiced law until the breaking out of the Mexican War, when he joined Col.
 Jack Hayes Regiment of Texas Rangers, being in Capt. Clebe HERRER's company,
 and took part in the battles of Buena Vista, Rosaca de la Palma and Monterey;
 his health being much improved after the war was over he returned to Adrian;
 he rode on horseback from Mexico to Kentucky, and from there to Michigan;
 immediately after his arrival was elected prosecuting attorney of Lenawee County,
 running far ahead of his ticket; he practiced law in Adrian for twenty-seven years
 and was one of the leading members of the bar; m. at Adrian, Michigan, 17th October,
 1831, Emma Louisa KEENEY, b. 6th October, 1824, at LeRoy, New York, dau. of
 Joseph and Mary (BISBOP) KEENEY, she now (1913) lives in St. Louis, Missouri.
